- b) As substantial knowledge of Greek Grammar is expected, be thorough with: Wenham, J.W. Elements of New Testament Greek (London: Cambridge University Press, 1965) and Moule, F.D. An Idiom Book of the New Testament Greek Cambridge (Cambridge University Press, 1953).
